PROCUREMENT OF INDIAN MAJOR CARP (IMC) FINGERLINGS FOR MONSOON STOCKING 2026

BNHS Inviting estimates tender under a **Two-Bid System** (Technical & Commercial) from reputed fish seed producers, hatchery owners, or experienced suppliers for the supply of 10 Lakh IMC fingerlings for the 2026 Monsoon Season (June – August 2026), to be released in Ujani Reservoir, Bhigwan, Maharashtra.

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3. Technical Specifications & Quality Control

- **Seed Quality:** Fingerlings must be healthy, active, and free from any visible symptoms of disease, parasites, or physical deformities.
- **Health Quality:** The supplier must provide a "Disease-Free" stock. Quality check will be done by BNHS officials at the time of securing stock and at the time of delivery.
- **Conditioning:** All seeds must be properly conditioned (starved in hapas) for a minimum of 24–48 hours prior to transport to ensure high survival rates.
- **Acclimatization:** On-site acclimatization to the water temperature of the release site is the responsibility of the supplier.

4. Packaging & Transportation

- **Method:** Fingerlings must be transported in oxygenated polythene bags packed in insulated containers or via specialized live-fish transport vehicles (Oxygenated Tanks).
- **Survival Rate:** A minimum of **95% survival** at the point of delivery/release is mandatory. Any mortality exceeding 5% shall be replaced by the supplier at no extra cost.
- **Delivery Timing:** Stocking must be completed during daylight hours (8:00 AM to 6:00 PM) to ensure proper monitoring and photography.

5. Eligibility Criteria (Technical Bid - Form A)

The bidder must enclose the following in the Technical Envelope:

1. **Experience:** Minimum 3 years of experience in supplying fish seeds to Government/Semi-Govt organizations.
2. **Financials:** Audited Balance Sheets for the last 3 financial years.
3. **Hatchery License:** Copy of a valid hatchery registration/license.
4. **Affidavit:** A self-declared "Non-Defaulter" affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper.
5. **Identity:** Copy of PAN Card and GST Registration.

6. Commercial Terms (Commercial Bid - Form B)

- Rates should be quoted **per 1,000 numbers**, inclusive of packing, oxygen, transportation, and all applicable taxes (F.O.R. Destination).
- **Payment:** 50% in advance to secure the stock, and after on ground verification from Project In-charge and 50% upon successful delivery and verifying survival rate (>90%).
