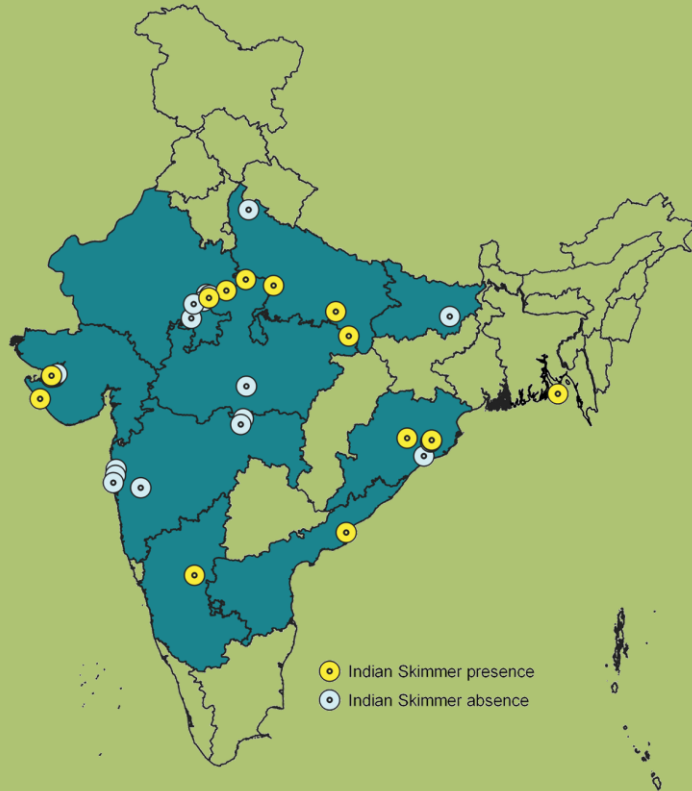

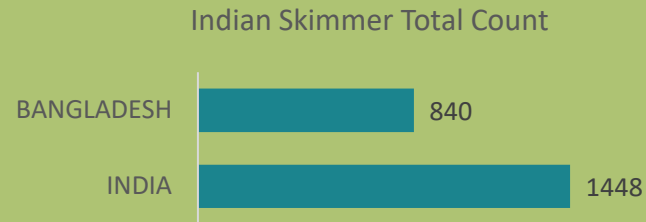
LOCATIONS VISTED DURING THE COUNT



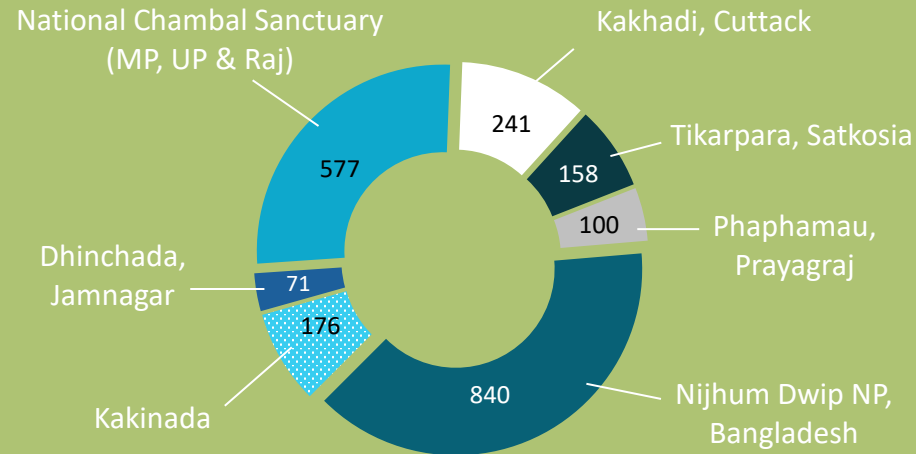

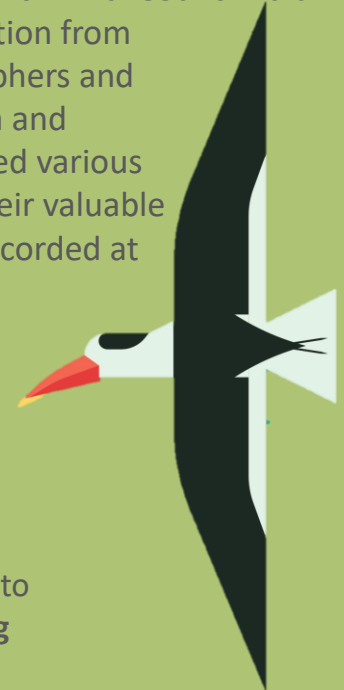


TOTAL COUNT AT THE HIGH CONGREGATION SITES



ABOUT THIS INITIATIVE

The aim of the Indian Skimmer Count was to gather information about the Indian Skimmer *Rynchops albicollis* population across its distribution range. It was conducted in two phases by Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS) in association with Bird Count India. The event saw participation from birdwatchers, photographers and other citizens from India and Bangladesh who surveyed various sites and contributed their valuable data. Skimmers were recorded at 13 sites in India and one site in Bangladesh
